- SHELLEY Late 30s. In charge of the kitchen for fifteen years. Catholic nun and former high school basketball star.
- EMMA 19. Rainbow-colored hair. Loves horror movies. Recently dropped out of college.
- OSCAR Late 20s or early 30s. Security guard working his way through community college. Completed a year of dental school in the Dominican Republic.
- FROG 50s or 60s. Homeless former hippie and academic. Writes joke books.

#### SETTING

A gleaming industrial kitchen in a Bronx church.

# **AUTHOR'S NOTES**

In the text of the play, line breaks indicate a shift in thought and do not necessarily demand a pause. Actors should feel free to play around with the rhythms of the spoken word and to make choices about punctuation.

Dialogue frequently overlaps, and a slash (/) indicates where the next speaker begins.

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# **Prologue**

(The sound of microwave buttons being pushed. SHELLEY stands in front of the microwave.)

#### SHELLEY. Uh

(She clears her throat.)

Sorry I'm stuck I'm stuck uh

Why don't I start

I'll just start

Uh

I pray for all people

For all places where there is war or famine I pray for our community

(Long beat.)

(... Justice for immigrants)

(Long beat.)

Sorry wow I'm so sorry

I'll keep working on this

(The microwave beeps.)

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#### Scene One

#### (EMMA and SHELLEY.)

**SHELLEY**. They can be high or drunk they can be falling down

as long as they aren't violent

If they're violent you call Oscar

The guys love him he's Dominican

He speaks Spanish and English and something else

He can fix things too

Officially he's maintenance

But he got roped into being our muscle

It's a long story and I don't want to scare you

(SHELLEY dumps several cups of barley into a pot of water as she talks.)

Since this might be their main nutrition we use beans, barley, brown rice, whole grains we change it up

All the veggies are in this big fridge

Zucchini, carrots, sometimes other squashes, no onions

Onion allergies are apparently on the rise

Here's a knife did you wash your hands?

#### EMMA. No

**SHELLEY.** Use that sink the water is brown in the other one for some reason

and then put on a pair of gloves You want to change your gloves often touch the garbage – change your gloves start a new vegetables – change your gloves that's probably overkill but I'm a clean freak so I'm gonna make you do it anyway Potatoes are in these boxes here You can use as many potatoes as you want they're good filler

EMMA. No meat?

SHELLEY. Oh yeah we serve steak and also we have Lobster Fridays
no it's too expensive
Dinners are fancier
this meal is just to get people through the day

We get a small crowd for lunch mostly men so in terms of interaction the main thing is to have boundaries

You can joke around with the guys

but don't let them own you and don't give them money

**EMMA**. ...Ok

(SHELLEY digs in the bottom drawer of the refrigerator.)

SHELLEY. Oh man Luis got these honking carrots again

(She emerges with a bag of gigantic carrots.)

You'll have to use the big knife try not to cut your finger I cut my fingers a couple of times a month (I'm trying to be more mindful)

(She surveys the vegetables.)

This here is what I call Shelley's famous barley carrot zucchini potato soup

(Beat.)

...How did you find us anyway?

**EMMA**. The Internet

SHELLEY. You were googling soup kitchens or

EMMA. Yeah no soup kitchens

I thought if I gave back in some way

if I did something for other people I thought it would help

SHELLEY. Help what

EMMA. Oh well them I guess the people who need help and also me

SHELLEY. How old are you?

EMMA. Nineteen.

**SHELLEY**. Are you in college?

EMMA. I was I dropped out I got kicked out

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. You wanna chop some carrots?

EMMA. ...Sure

(They start chopping.)

Are a lot of them falling down drunk the guys who come here

SHELLEY. No most of our guests are very polite especially the regulars

But you do have to be careful because any one of them could snap

There's this one guy Frog

He'll try to sell you these joke books

(A rock hits the window. They both jump. **SHELLEY** runs to the doorway.)

EMMA. Iesus SHELLEY. (shouting)

Oscar! (sorry)

Hey Oscar!

**SHELLEY**. It's shatterproof don't worry

Oscar!

It's kids they think it's funny

Oscar will scare them away

**OSCAR** 

(OSCAR enters.)

**OSCAR**. Hey where's my sandwich

SHELLEY. It's those P.S. 96 kids throwing rocks again

OSCAR. Yeah I got it but then I need my sandwich

(to EMMA) Hi

(to SHELLEY) She's cute

I mean you're my true love Shelley

You're my love for all space and time

but she's cute too

SHELLEY. Hurry up

OSCAR. Ok but don't worry

Ladies

I AM COMING BACK

(OSCAR exits.)

**SHELLEY**. He's uh

He brings a lot of energy to the place.

(Small beat. **SHELLEY** looks around the kitchen.)

Uh

Ok

After this we'll clean the dining room

sweep up

The tables can be wiped down with that

Stuff

under there

EMMA. Do you use organic cleaning products

**SHELLEY**. Ha

No

EMMA. I'm sorry it's just I'm allergic

To chemical cleaners

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. I guess you're in charge of the sweeping

(OSCAR re-enters.)

OSCAR. Ok ladies they're gone

I threatened to cut their fingers off with these pliers now I need my sandwich

**SHELLEY.** Good work

OSCAR. Does that mean you'll see a movie with me

SHELLEY. Ha ha ha here

OSCAR. How come it's always Roast Beef

**SHELLEY.** Because Roast Beef is your favorite

**OSCAR**. (as he's eating) Oh yeah.

(He looks EMMA up and down as he eats his sandwich.)

You really are pretty

like a Greek Goddess what's-her-name Icarus

**SHELLEY**. Don't play dumb Icarus was a boy

He knows that he goes to City College

Don't play dumb you think it's charming but it's not

OSCAR. Oh right Icarus is the guy whose wings melted

I forgot I did I forgot!

I meant the goddess who's

Iris

the Rainbow one

SHELLEY. Why because of her hair?

**OSCAR**. Yeah I like that

what you've done with your hair very creative

EMMA. Oh yeah it's

I was hating myself

and I thought maybe if I changed my hair

I wouldn't notice it was me...?

OSCAR. Ok so you're crazy

No that's Ok that's hot

I mean it's like I'm gonna stay away

but you're still hot

you know

from way back here from a distance

SHELLEY. Be nice Oscar

EMMA. I don't actually hate myself all the time, Oscar

I was just having a bad day but I feel a lot better now that I'm

(She makes a goddessy gesture.)

...Iris

OSCAR. Heh

Yeah

It's a full moon tonight Sister Shelley don't get too wild Biggest full moon in 20 years so

(Pause.)

...watch out.

(OSCAR exits.)

(SHELLEY and EMMA chop.)

EMMA. He's cute.

(They chop.)

Sorry you're not supposed to notice that right?

SHELLEY. How would I not notice that?

**EMMA**. Yeah but aren't you supposed to detach from those feelings or

SHELLEY. No not from feelings no

(They chop.)

...Just from outcomes

(After a bit:)

EMMA. Sorry if I'm being nosy

but how come you don't wear a head thing

SHELLEY. A lot of us stopped doing that in the seventies

(They chop.)

Although some of the younger nuns are bringing it back

I have no idea why

A group of them play basketball across the street

in their habits

EMMA. Whoa

(SHELLEY chops rather violently.)

**SHELLEY.** Yeah half-court ball because they can't move very fast

I mean I love basketball

but I am not playing in a dress

Go ahead and dump the vegetables into the pot.

(EMMA dumps all of her vegetables into the pot. SHELLEY does the same.)

And now we put the lid on.

(SHELLEY puts the lid on. She gestures to a bunch of cleaning supplies in the corner.)

Why don't you grab that broom and I'll show you the dining area

EMMA. Ok wait let me

(EMMA goes to her bag and gets out an allergy mask. She puts it on. SHELLEY looks at her.)

**SHELLEY.** Super

(They exit.)

#### Scene Two

(FROG enters. He goes to the big fridge. He opens it. He starts snacking on vegetables. EMMA enters carrying the broom and dustpan. She is still wearing the allergy mask. She sees FROG.)

EMMA. Oscar

Oscar

FROG. Hey whoa calm / down

EMMA. OSCAR

FROG. Whoa it's me it's Frog

Calm down

Are you / new

EMMA. You're Frog?

FROG. (obviously) Yeah

EMMA. I'm sorry sir

Frog

You need to wait out in the cafeteria

We'll be serving lunch in a few minutes

FROG. Yeah but I'm a snacker

EMMA. Ok but you can't / be in here

FROG. Would you like to buy a joke?

(Beat.)

EMMA. How much.

FROG. One joke is a quarter

or I can sell you the whole book for a buck

There's at least 30 jokes in the book

It's a much better deal

EMMA. Oh uh

**FROG**. Why didn't the chicken cross the road?

EMMA. I don't know.

Why didn't the chicken cross / the

FROG. No training

(Beat. EMMA starts laughing.)

You see

Give me a dollar you need this book

EMMA. I'm sorry I don't have any cash / on me

FROG. You can have it for free I trust you

EMMA. Oh no / I couldn't

FROG. Take it.

Take it

EMMA. Thank you ok wait I actually do have a dollar in my bag

I don't know why I said I didn't

(She gives him a dollar and puts the book in her bag.)

You won't be sorry I'm a fortune-teller too I come from a long line of gypsies of Romani sorry the Romani people so I can see your future and you have a lot of laughs coming your way

(SHELLEY enters with an arm full of dirty serving platters.)

SHELLEY. Hey Frog you know you can't be in here.

FROG. I can go anywhere I want Shelley

(He turns back to EMMA.)

For a while I was in exile they banished me The cops picked me up in Eugene, Oregon and instead of taking me to jail they gave me a one-way ticket to Berkeley, California "Because it's always warm in Berkeley"

SHELLEY. It's not always warm / in Berkeley

FROG. Warmer than / here

SHELLEY. Frog, go get in line

FROG. Berkeley sucks too many bums

SHELLEY. Frog

FROG. (to EMMA) Shattuck street – you ever been?

Shitsuck Street

bums puking all over your shoes

stupid cracked out hippies

SHELLEY. I'm calling security.

(FROG is gone.)

Did you buy one of his books

EMMA. ...Yeah

SHELLEY. Ok then you're contributing to his alcoholism

EMMA. It was a dollar

SHELLEY. A dollar toward his death.

Don't encourage him he's a manipulator

EMMA. He seems so nice

SHELLEY. Yeah well he got in a fight once

right out there on the corner of 196th and Grand Concourse

broke a guys collarbone

He just snapped ok any of them can snap so you need to pay attention when / I

EMMA. I have cancer.

SHELLEY. What

EMMA. That's why I have to wear this mask

I know you think I'm wimpy

I could tell by the way you were looking at me in this mask

but I'm not a wimp I have cancer

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. I'm sorry I had no idea

**EMMA**. It's ok it's not your / fault

SHELLEY. I'm so sorry what kind of

EMMA. Leukemia

The kid kind so that's lucky

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. Are you sure you're all right to -

EMMA. Yes yes I'm fine

It's good for me to get out and do stuff as long as I'm careful

I'm sorry I should / have told you

SHELLEY. No no please you have nothing to be sorry for

(OSCAR enters.)

OSCAR. Hey are we on schedule

**EMMA**. That was a very poor response time Oscar

**OSCAR**. Hey crazy

There's a huge line out there is that pot ready to run

SHELLEY. Uh

Yes I think we're ready

(She picks up the pot of soup with potholders and hands it to OSCAR. OSCAR takes the pot and ushers the ladies out in front of him.)

OSCAR. Let's get it moving ladies

Right this way

(They exit. As he is disappearing:)

Showtime!

#### Scene Three

(EMMA, wearing her allergy mask, lugs in two giant recycling bags filled with paper plates. She unlocks the back door, looks around and tosses them into the cans. She shuts the door quickly and locks it. She takes off her mask. She's exhausted.)

(OSCAR enters carrying the giant soup pot.)

**OSCAR**. You hungry

You want some of this leftover soup

EMMA. No thanks

oscar. Seriously you should eat that takes a lot of energy and you're not even good at it yet
Wait till you get to my level

I always have a big bowl of soup afterwards because I deserve it

You wanna join me

EMMA. Uh

OSCAR. C'mon a little fellowship here

(He ladles out two bowls of soup and puts them in the microwave.)

You mind if I nuke 'em?

EMMA. ...No

OSCAR. Hey are you ok

EMMA. Yeah yeah I'm

That was a little overwhelming

OSCAR. First time can be rough You can't let 'em wear you out gotta protect yourself

EMMA. That's a lot of I don't know Need

OSCAR. Desperation man that's desperation

**EMMA.** I feel like I'm covered in gunk now I feel desperate too like it's contagious

I think I'm gonna go home and take a shower and then maybe go to Sephora try out some new products

#### OSCAR. Oh man

Sephora

My girlfriend spends her whole paycheck there then I gotta pay for her to eat

EMMA. (digging in her bag) Yeah I get it

It makes you feel really good about yourself

Here I'll show you

This is a brand called Benefit

the packaging is really pleasing

Look at this

This is a whole kit for your eyes

OSCAR. Oh yeah that is pretty

## EMMA. Right?

This covers up your dark circles

And this you can use to put a little shimmer

under the brow bone

And here I'm going to line my eyes

(He heads to the microwave to prepare the soup as she makes her eyes a little more glamorous.)

# OSCAR. Hey do what you gotta do

Just don't poke your eye out

My sister almost did that once had to wear a patch

She worked it though

still had dudes asking her out

(The microwave buzzes.)

Soup's ready.

# EMMA. Just a second

(OSCAR brings over two steaming bowls of soup and utensils.)

OSCAR. Wow you look good that stuff really works

**EMMA.** This is my Buxom lip gloss and plumper It tingles

(She smoothes the lip gloss on her lips.)

It actually makes my lips plumper

that's why it stings

Like a bee has actually stung my lip

Do they look plumper

(Beat.)

#### **OSCAR.** I dunno

(He starts eating the soup. As he's eating he sort of mumbles.)

I know that personally

I would not want that crap in my soup

(She laughs.)

(She takes one of the napkins and wipes off the lipgloss.)

(She starts eating the soup.)

EMMA. Do you ever work here at night

OSCAR. I do sometimes yeah

On Fridays

EMMA. So like this Friday

OSCAR. Uh no

I'm off this Friday

EMMA. Is it scary

OSCAR. Nah

There's guys hanging around

but they're just looking for handouts or a warm place to sleep

EMMA. Right but are there ghosts

OSCAR. Uh no I don't think so

**EMMA**. It would be cool to spend the night in a spooky old church

I like to get freaked out

(They eat.)

**OSCAR.** So you

I guess you like horror movies then

EMMA. Oh yeah

I'm not like most girls I fucking love horror movies

The Omen is my favorite

Old Timey horror

OSCAR. That's cool my girl is not into them at all

My girlfriend

Rosa

She makes me go to girl movies

**EMMA.** Some night I'm gonna show up here and scare the shit out of you

(SHELLEY enters with an armload of tablecloths and napkin.)

(She shoves them into a hamper as she talks.)

**SHELLEY.** Oscar will you put the chairs away after you eat Those nice lady volunteers just bailed

Rafa told them he had lice

OSCAR, Sure

EMMA. Which one is Rafa?

OSCAR. The guy with the nasty hair down to his butt

(SHELLEY grabs a mop and bucket from the closet.)

EMMA. He has lice?

OSCAR.

SHELLEY.

No

**Probably** 

**OSCAR**. No he doesn't

He was just messing with the ladies

SHELLEY. I bet he does have lice but that doesn't mean we can all run screaming back to wherever Riverdale

(SHELLEY is gone.)

EMMA. Shouldn't we go help her

OSCAR. No way she never stops working

she's got super powers from God

I'm telling you she comes in at 6 a.m.

so she can clean up after the janitors

You try and keep up you'll never get outta here

Just eat your soup. That's my advice

EMMA. Yeah ok

(They eat.)

Hey this is actually pretty good

OSCAR. Yeah it's not bad for bum soup right

Soup desperados

Could use some more pepper

(He grabs some pepper and shakes it in his soup.)

EMMA. I'll take some in my soup too

**OSCAR**. Sure

(He reaches his hand out to give her the pepper.)

(EMMA doesn't take the pepper.)

EMMA. Go ahead.

(Beat.)

OSCAR. You want me to put the pepper in your soup EMMA. Yeah

(Beat.)

OSCAR. Like I'm a waiter?

EMMA. Yeah

Like you're a waiter

(Beat.)

(OSCAR reluctantly peppers her soup.)

#### **Scene Four**

(Early morning. The sound of microwave buttons being pushed. The kitchen is still dark. **SHELLEY** stands in front of the microwave.)

#### SHELLEY. Uh

(She clears her throat.)

Ok

Why don't I start I'll just start

...I pray for all people

for all places where there is war or famine

I pray for our community

(Beat.)

(...Justice for immigrants)

(Beat.)

Forgive me but it feels pointless

lately

Keeping these people alive with so little

And I think I have skills that might be more useful

I'm not even a good cook so

My mind is shriveling up

I used to think the conversations I had here

Deeper and more meaningful than those I have with my peers

Forgive me they are my peers too

I know their value I do I'm just grumpy

I'd feel worse if I had to spend my days

With a bunch a jerk laywers like my dad

He's uh

He's still hanging on and I know I need to reach out

To forgive

but sometimes I wish

he would just hurry up and die

Forgive me

(EMMA enters and stands in the doorway.)

I know that you are looking at me with gentleness I know that whatever my faults

You will continue to look at me with gentleness

(The microwave beeps. **SHELLEY** crosses herself. Turns to see she's not alone and panics.)

Emma

Hi

EMMA. Oscar let me in I hope that's ok

SHELLEY. Are you on the schedule

EMMA. No but I had bloodwork up the street so

I thought I'd stop by

see if you and Oscar needed any help

**SHELLEY**. Oh ok most volunteers don't come back the next day

or at all so good for you

but we don't start serving til two and I uh

(SHELLEY looks at EMMA's hopeful face.)

You know what come on in anyway I'm just planning the menu Have you eaten yet

EMMA. Not really

SHELLEY. Why don't you sit down

I'll make you a sandwich

Is Roast Beef ok it's all we've got

EMMA. I love Roast Beef but I'm not hungry I'm here to help

(SHELLEY goes to the fridge.)

SHELLEY. Well you need to eat

so I am making you this sandwich and I am sticking it in the fridge for later

Ok?

Don't let Oscar eat it

he could eat ten sandwiches at a time

**EMMA**. Thank you

(SHELLEY starts making EMMA's sandwich. After a moment:)

SHELLEY. ... Do you have people taking care of you

EMMA. Yeah my mom but she's driving me crazy

I mean I know she's worried but

I just want her to treat me like a normal person

SHELLEY. ...Sure

(EMMA watches SHELLEY make the sandwich. SHELLEY smiles at her.)

Hey guess what

One of our parishioners

donated a bunch of eggplant today

Do you have any idea what to do with those?

**EMMA**. Not really

**SHELLEY**. Yeah me either

We usually stick to the basics around here but

Sandwich!

I found this eggplant soup recipe

on Epicurious

You want to figure it out together

**EMMA**. Sure

(OSCAR enters carrying a box of canned goods. He notices EMMA.)

**OSCAR.** (*to* **EMMA**) Oh wow she let you stay I guess she loves you

**SHELLEY**. (*still holding up the eggplant*) Hey Oscar what do you call this in Spanish?

**OSCAR.** Eggplant I mean berenjena Berenjenas

**SHELLEY**. Do you know what the heck to do with it

OSCAR. Yeah, you just scoop it out and fry the guts in a pan

(He sets the box down, opens it and starts stocking one of the shelves.)

**SHELLEY**. The guts

OSCAR. Yeah it's delicious like mashed potatoes

SHELLEY. Right but we have to put it in a soup

EMMA. Duh

OSCAR. Ok well then you know what's delicious is eggplant in a pork stew my sister makes that Why don't you make that

SHELLEY. It's lunch we can't afford pork

OSCAR. Ok but I'm saying I personally if it were up to me I would chop it up and make a pork and eggplant stew can I get my sandwich

EMMA. Here I got it

(EMMA goes to the fridge, opens it and pulls out a sandwich.)

(As **SHELLEY** squints at the recipe, **EMMA** unwraps the sandwich.)

(Looking right at OSCAR, she starts eating it.)

SHELLEY. So I just chunk it up Oscar?

(OSCAR is staring at EMMA.)

Do I leave this skin on?

OSCAR. Yes yes you leave the skin on because it has vitamins

This girl is eating my sandwich!

(EMMA starts laughing.)

EMMA. I'm not I'm not this is my sandwich Shelley made this for me THIS IS MY SANDWICH

OSCAR. Girl is crazy

(EMMA takes out OSCAR's sandwich.)

EMMA. (laughing) Dude here's your sandwich

(EMMA is laughing almost hysterically now.)

(**SHELLEY** is a little confused.)

SHELLEY. Ok let's all just

calm down

Oscar we have a lot of work to do and too many cooks in the kitchen So

OSCAR. I didn't do anything she did it!

**SHELLEY**. I'm just saying we've got to Grapple

(Holding up the eggplant.)

With this

**OSCAR.** I hear you Shelley I'm gonna leave you two alone (Go eat my sandwich)

(He exits.)

(SHELLEY is still holding the eggplant.)

EMMA. You want me to try?

SHELLEY. Please

(EMMA takes the eggplant and starts cutting it up slowly, but fairly confidently. SHELLEY watches her, impressed.)

All right that's your job

(SHELLEY goes to grab a bunch of potatoes.)

EMMA. So you like

pray to the microwave

SHELLEY, What

Oh

No

Ha

No I don't pray to the

I don't worship the microwave

EMMA. The microwave god

SHELLEY. No no the microwave

(Beat.)

It's for keeping time I was timing my prayer

EMMA. Why

SHELLEY. Uh

I've been having a trouble praying Lately

EMMA. Whoa you're a nun

SHELLEY. Right but it's something I'm struggling with nevertheless

EMMA. And the microwave helps?

SHELLEY. Well the timer helps

I've been forcing myself to pray for one minute

I'm trying to work up to two and eventually five

EMMA. Whoa

SHELLEY. Yep

(SHELLEY starts chopping potatoes. They chop for a bit.)

EMMA. Do you like picture a face when you pray

SHELLEY. No

I don't

EMMA. When I was a kid we said that prayer

"If I should die before I wake

I pray the lord my soul to take"

So I always pictured a monster with a giant mouth just waiting for me to die so he could eat my soul

(They chop. **SHELLEY** doesn't quite know what to say. She clears her throat.)

**SHELLEY**. If you'd like to talk to someone about praying

I'm sure Father Nolan would be happy / to

#### **EMMA**. Ew no thanks

(They keep chopping. After a few moments:)

#### SHELLEY. Uh

When I was learning to pray

I was taught to imagine a real person who loved me

Unconditionally

So I would just talk to my Grandma

she was crazy about me

and she was dead so she couldn't change her mind

(FROG enters. SHELLEY doesn't look up.)

Frog Out

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#### **Scene Five**

(Sounds of shuffling around in the dark.)

(Muttering in Spanish.)

(Sound of a woman laughing.)

**OSCAR**. What are you

What are you

Oh Jesus

What are you doing

(OSCAR is breathing heavily.)

Ta pasao

Tu ta pasao

Tu ta pasao

(OSCAR comes. Beat.) ForProfessional

#### Scene Six

(Morning. FROG and OSCAR in the kitchen. OSCAR cooks eggs.)

FROG. So after that

Let me say that I had also eaten many mushrooms
Purple heads so I should have been having Visions
but for some reason I wasn't
The experience it was
It was purely tactile
I might as well have eaten ecstasy
which is fine I love ecstasy
but I was looking for a transformational experience
and ecstasy does not transform
it keeps you solidly in this

(FROG pats his belly.)

So after that I had to quit

There was no other choice

(He pats his belly again.)

Geez I'm getting fat all this soup

OSCAR. You're not fat Papi

FROG. Oh yeah

OSCAR. You like the yolk hard or soft

FROG. Oh hard as hard as you can get it otherwise I think about the dead baby chick

That's an embryo you know that's an abortion

OSCAR. Hey come on

FROG. I'm sorry my friend but that's what it is

I was a vegetarian for years

First just to piss off my parents but then I really meant it And then I didn't eat anything at all for a whole month because I got to thinking that plants are alive too I would eat some iceberg lettuce feel it crunch between my teeth hear the screams of pain Carrot sticks were the worst the sound they make oh man ahhhhh

(He covers his ears for a second.)

You know what I'm talking about?
Snapping carrot bones with your murderous teeth?

OSCAR. Carrots don't have bones man

FROG. Sure they do they've got a spine

You know that little inside tube of the carrot

You know the tube the delicate tube

That's the Spine and listen when you start to realize that everything is alive

and trust me everything is alive

then you start to realize you have a choice to make

You can either decide that you are a predator

No different than a lion or a

piranha

crushing life in your murderous teeth

or you can starve to death

That's your choice

(Beat.)

And it's bleak

It's a bleak choice

Look the sun is coming up

Love it.

Love the sun

Love the sun

Is there coffee

OSCAR. Yeah

You take milk sugar

FROG. Oh no Black

Black black black

**OSCAR.** Man I don't know how you can drink it without sugar

**FROG.** Yeah well I'm epileptic and the sugar makes it worse Epilepsy

You know what that is

"Epilepsia"

**OSCAR**. Yeah ok

FROG. I can say it five different languages just in case

When I was young I was a global adventurer

I've been all over Europe

I've been to Africa

that big warm cradle

Also I wear this thing this necklace

Tells people what my deal is

in case I flip out on a subway platform or on the sidewalk

That's another reason I quite the drugs

and the alcohol

You wouldn't know it

But I actually take very good care of myself

You should tell Shelley tell her

tell her I'm not a drunk

Tell that Gargoyle I look out / for myself

OSCAR. Here you go here's your eggs

(He hands him a plate of eggs.)

FROG. Aren't you going to eat

**OSCAR**. I can't I'm thinking of the baby chicks

**FROG.** Well you're going to have to eat at some point At some point you're going to have to make peace

with being a murderer

(FROG eats his eggs with relish.)

(OSCAR drinks coffee.)

(FROG makes growling noises.)

OSCAR. Frog cut it out.

(FROG continues to eat.)

FROG. Hey Oscar

Why did the boy drop his ice cream

OSCAR. I don't know why

FROG. Because he got hit by a truck

(Beat.)

**OSCAR.** Man I'm sorry but I don't understand your jokes maybe it's my English

FROG. Your English is perfect

**OSCAR.** Jokes are the last thing you understand in another language

Sucks

I need special English as a Second Language jokes I guess

FROG. Listen my friend

My jokes don't make any sense don't worry about it

Hey how's your girl

what's her name

**OSCAR.** Rosa

FROG. Oh yeah Rosa I like her

How's she doing

OSCAR. She's good

Oh

Yeah

Papi she's great she's

She wants me to marry her so I'm working up to that

FROG. What the hell does that mean

**OSCAR**. Well I don't have the cash to provide for her right now

So it doesn't seem right to marry her

Once I get my degree I can get a better job / and

FROG. What kind of job you gonna get

There are no jobs my friend don't delude yourself

There are no jobs

There are no jobs

Marry her now you guys can figure it out together This is the 21st century you don't have to support her In the 21st Century men and women they support each other

You see:

(He makes a gesture with his hands that resembling "this is the church, this is the steeple.")

I am holding you up while you are holding up me It's fucking beautiful

The 21st century

The 21st century

Isn't this what you really want

(He makes the gesture again.)

This right here

OSCAR. Yeah that sounds nice

FROG. Oh it's nice it's nice

**OSCAR**. You have a girl

FROG. No no no no no

That's not my way Oscar

OSCAR. You what gay Frog you

FROG. All I'm going to say about this Oscar

Is that it is not my way

and then I'm going to leave you to draw

whatever conclusions you like

I'll tell you one thing though

Unlike some people I am not a playa

(Beat.)

OSCAR. Oh man what are you talking about / 'playa'

FROG. Well my friend I'm camping near the rectory now

OSCAR. Frog you know you're not supposed to camp

FROG. I know but I am

I am camping near the rectory and I saw

Oh yeah

Oh yeah

Round 3 a.m. I saw her come in

Oh yeah

And then later I saw her go out

Oh yeah

(Beat.)

You got something to say about that

OSCAR. Shit

FROG. Oh yeah

OSCAR. She just showed up

FROG. All her fault huh

**OSCAR**. Yeah

Actually!

I was sleeping and I opened my eyes and

There she was right there front of me

I thought I was dreaming

Oh man c'mon it was a mistake

Let's forget about it I'm going to forget about it

I gotta headache now

FROG. Yeah but did you have sex with her

OSCAR. No no no I didn't I

I didn't have sex with her

She did it all without any help from me!

I did nothing I didn't even touch her

She did it all and then she left it was like a dream

So you see I think technically I'm in the clear with Rosa

because

One: We didn't technically have sex

And Two: I thought I was dreaming

(Beat.)

**FROG.** Sweet dream

(OSCAR nods.)

#### Scene Seven

(Sound of microwave buttons being pushed.)

(SHELLEY stands at the microwave.)

(She stares at the microwave for about 30 seconds.)

SHELLEY. Uh

(Pause. She sighs.)

I'm / sorry

ForProfessiona

(The microwave buzzes. She crosses herself.)

## **Scene Eight**

(OSCAR and SHELLEY. OSCAR is eating his sandwich. He's a little jumpy, as if he's waiting for someone to arrive. SHELLEY preps the soup.)

**OSCAR**. You know I was gonna be a dentist right

I went back and did a year of training in the DR

But none of it counts here

That's the problem

If I want to be a dentist here I've gotta start all over

And yeah I could go back to the DR

set up a clinic make a shitload of money

but I don't wanna go back there my life is here now

New York City is the new Dominican Republic

SHELLEY. Can you grab me that pot from up there

OSCAR. You know most fools in the DR think that New York

City

IS America

Yeah

My cousin called last week

he said Oscar we're moving to New York City and I said shit that's great news do you need a place to live and he said no no no man we found a place

in Miami SHELLEY. Ha

OSCAR. So one date Shelley what do you say?

SHELLEY. Get back to work Oscar

OSCAR. I'm teasing you!

I mean sometimes it's fun to think

Could I compete with God

and I think

Yeah

(SHELLEY reacts.)

I'm kidding!

C'mon I'm kidding I respect you and also I love Rosa I love Rosa you know I do

**SHELLEY.** How is Rosa

OSCAR. Oh she's good she's good

she's gotta new job

Yeah she's gonna be making more money than me She's working at Macy's

SHELLEY. That's great

OSCAR. Hey is that girl coming in again today

**SHELLEY**. Who

Emma

OSCAR. Yeah she disappeared what's up with that

**SHELLEY**. Uh

I'm not sure I haven't heard from her

OSCAR. Oh really ok cause she's crazy

SHELLEY. She has a lot going on right now

OSCAR. She got a lot of problems huh rich girl problems

SHELLEY. I don't think she's rich

OSCAR. Between you and me I think girl's a crazy bitch

SHELLEY. Oscar!

**OSCAR.** Sorry

Sorry I never use that word I'm sorry Shelley will you forgive me

 $(\textit{It's not clear whether \textbf{SHELLEY}} \ will \ for give \ him.)$ 

It's just there's something about her she freaks me out

SHELLEY. You don't know anything about her

OSCAR. Oh I know some things

SHELLEY. You need to be kind to her do you hear me

OSCAR. Not if she's batshit crazy I don't

SHELLEY. Oscar shut up she's sick ok she's very / sick

OSCAR. What do you mean she's sick

**SHELLEY**. Never mind I don't know if I / should

OSCAR. Yeah but wait is she like

(Beat.)

Is it contagious?

SHELLEY. Oscar!

**OSCAR.** Sorry I

SHELLEY. No it's not contagious

OSCAR. Ok sorry I'm just saying

She shouldn't be serving soup if she's gonna be infectious

SHELLEY. What is with you Oscar

**OSCAR**. I don't know!

Something

Something's up with me

SHELLEY, Yeah

(After a moment:)

OSCAR. Rosa and I are

We've been fighting all week and I don't know why

It's stressing me out

I'm sorry Shelley is that girl going to be ok

SHELLEY. I don't know I hope so

(Beat.)

Do you mind chopping some vegetables

OSCAR. No way that's women's work

Ha I'm kidding

Here I'll do the carrots

(As he talks, **OSCAR** puts a pair of gloves on and starts chopping.)

Hey just so you know

Frog's camping in the rectory

SHELLEY. What no he can't do that

OSCAR. I know but he is

S'okay if I give him breakfast

SHELLEY. Oscar he can't camp

**OSCAR**. I know but is it ok if I feed him until he gets caught (She sighs.)

SHELLEY. Yes

OSCAR. I knew you'd say yes

You nuns are sneaky

Sneaky for God

(A rock hits the window.)

SHELLEY. Oh c'mon!

(She runs opens the back door and shouts.)

HEY

WHERE THE HECK ARE YOUR / TEACHERS

OSCAR. Shelley I got it

I'll take care of it

(OSCAR runs out past her.)

SHELLEY. JESUS LOVES YOU

BUT YOU'RE MAKING IT HARD FOR HIM

(She slams the door. Another rock hits the window. Then another. Then it stops.)

(SHELLEY goes back to the vegetables. She starts chopping rather violently. She stops. She breathes. There's a timid knocking on the door. EMMA opens the door. She's wearing a scarf on her head.)

Emma

ЕММА. Ні

SHELLEY. It's great to see you I was so worried

EMMA. I'm sorry I had a bunch of appointments I'm should have called

**SHELLEY**. No no that's fine I'm happy to see you

EMMA. I'd love to help out today if that's all right

SHELLEY. Of course it is come on in

How are you feeling

EMMA. Uh

Well I'm on steroids now so that's kind of messing with me emotionally

(**FROG** enters.)

FROG. Oh no

Your pretty hair

SHELLEY. Frog leave her alone

EMMA. (to FROG) Don't worry it's still there

It's just getting kinda stringy

FROG. Well even with no hair

you are much more attractive

than the person they had serving soup last week

EMMA. Aw thanks Frog

FROG. Oh god I hate the thought of them putting you in that

big radiation machine

Have you thought about doing something more holistic

**EMMA**. There's no machine

They just use a catheter and pump the chemicals right into me

(She pulls down her shirt to reveal a bandage covering a port on her upper chest.)

FROG. I don't like the looks of that

I think you should look into some holistic methods I know they're doing some good stuff down in Mexico

SHELLEY. Sloan Kettering is the best in the country

FROG. Yeah but this country's out to kill us

SHELLEY. Frog you need to get out of here it's almost ten

FROG. I will Shelley I just wanna be supportive ok

**SHELLEY.** Tasha's coming at ten and she can't see you in here

FROG. Loud and clear Shelley

(OSCAR enters.)

**OSCAR**. Oh hey

FROG. Emma's back from her Chemotherapy

SHELLEY. Frog!

EMMA. It's ok I have to tell people at some point

(Beat. **OSCAR** looks stricken.)

OSCAR. Oh

Wow

It's cancer

My mom went through that shit I'm really sorry I'm going to pray for you

(Beat.)

EMMA. Hey you guys wanna see a picture of my doctor

He's cute he looks

kind of like a bald Johnny Depp

(OSCAR shifts uncomfortably as EMMA shows them the photo.)

FROG. He's ok I know some handsomer men

Personally

But I've travelled a lot

EMMA. And look isn't this nice

Tons of people sent me flowers

(She scrolls through her phone.)

FROG. What's this one

Just you in front of the hospital?

EMMA. Yeah I'm documenting everything I don't know why

**FROG.** Gives you a feeling of control in an uncontrollable situation

(The church bell starts ringing.)

SHELLEY. Ok Frog you're out

Go

 $G_0$ 

FROG. I'm going Shelley I'm going sheesh

(He blows a kiss to EMMA.)

Stay strong

SHELLEY, GO

(FROG Exits.)

**OSCAR.** I should get back to my

(Uncomfortable beat.)

EMMA. Ok

I'll see you

OSCAR. ...Yeah

(He exits. SHELLEY notices that's something's wrong with EMMA.)

SHELLEY. You're sure you feel well enough to work...?

EMMA. I don't need any special treatment

I'm gonna make some kick ass soup

**SHELLEY**. I like your attitude

But if you need a break you have to / speak up

EMMA. I know

(She goes to a box and takes out some carrots.)

SHELLEY. Hey!

Sorry uh

I'm so sorry I didn't meant to yell

Just please don't touch those vegetables without washing your hands

(EMMA is a little taken aback. She walks over to the sink, washes her hands, and puts on gloves. SHELLEY goes to the fridge and starts rummaging around.)

(EMMA starts chopping.)

(from the fridge) We need extra everything it's getting crazy out there

almost twice as many guys as last week

Pretty soon the whole city's gonna be homeless It feels like the end of the / world

**EMMA**. Ow shit I cut my

SHELLEY. Are you ok

**EMMA**. I cut my finger /

I cut my finger

SHELLEY. Here c'mon

Let's put it under the faucet

**EMMA**. I cut my finger

(EMMA starts crying.)

I cut my finger

I'm fine I'm fine it's not deep

(SHELLEY holds EMMA's finger under the faucet.)

It's not deep

It's not deep

(EMMA is sobbing.

SHELLEY. You're ok

Take a deep breath and just count

Count it out

Count from one to 20

**EMMA**. 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6

SHELLEY. Here let me look at it

Keep counting

**EMMA**. 7, 8, 9

(SHELLEY examines EMMA's finger.)

10, 11, 12

SHELLEY. I can't even see the cut

It's like it already healed

It's like a miracle

(EMMA grabs on tightly to SHELLEY.)

#### Scene Nine

(Later that same day, After lunch service. The bell rings three times as OSCAR carries in a bunch of dishes while pressing his cell phone to his ear with his shoulder.)

OSCAR. Estaba bromeando

era una broma estúpida!

Rosa, estoy en el trabajo

no me hagas esto

Voy a llegar a las seis y después salimos

A donde quiere ir

(FROG enters.)

¿Que?

Ese no fue lo que dije

Disculpame, pero no es lo que dije

Rosa.

Rosa.

Rosa

Mierda

(OSCAR hangs up.)

FROG. Hey Oscar

OSCAR. Hey

**FROG.** How can you tell if a man has been having oral sex with a duck?

OSCAR. I don't know

(FROG blows a bunch of white feathers into the air.)

(It's quite beautiful.)

FROG. That was for you man you see

That's an English as a Second Language joke

(FROG exits.)

(OSCAR grabs a broom and starts sweeping up the feathers.)

(From the dining room he hears:)

EMMA. OSCAR.

OSCAR.

WE NEED YOU OUT HERE OSCAR.

SHELLEY, OSCAR.

OSCAR, Shit

(He exits.)

(After a few moments: From offstage, OSCAR can be heard screaming. This is followed by loud shouts and laughter from SHELLEY and EMMA. EMMA and SHELLEY enter, still laughing, their arms laden with dishes.)

(EMMA wears a homemade "freaky face" mask.)

SHELLEY. Oh my gosh that was amazing

You scared the heck out of him

EMMA. He screamed like a girl!

OSCAR. (off) THAT WAS NOT FUNNY

LADIES YOU ARE NOT FUNNY

SHELLEY. Oh no

I might pee

I might pee

(EMMA laughs even harder.)

No never mind I'm ok I'm fine

I'm not going to pee

Oh man!

His face

Amazing you're amazing

they love you those guys

You bring a lot of light into that situation

and that is not easy believe me

EMMA. Can I ask you something weird

Do you ever fantasize about washing their feet?

(Beat.)

(SHELLEY starts laughing again.)

**SHELLEY.** Sorry I'm sorry it's

(She can't stop laughing.)

No No I do not think about

(SHELLEY can't stop laughing.)

I don't even like feet

EMMA. C'mon!

I mean didn't you ever think about stuff like that When you wanted to become a nun

SHELLEY. No nope no I did not

EMMA. Ok but what about other stuff

Like couldn't we help them find jobs

SHELLEY. (sobering up a little) Oh

Uh

That's a great idea but that's not what we do here We don't have the resources for that

EMMA. Yeah but it's just phone calls right

Hooking them up with places that are hiring

Helping them find clothes

I could teach them to make resumes

**SHELLEY.** Well you'd need a little money for that and a whole lot of time

Do you mind passing me that sponge

EMMA. Would you mind if I did some research

SHELLEY. No no please do some

Research

(SHELLEY starts scrubbing the pot.)

EMMA. So what did you think about?

When you first wanted to become a nun

What did / you

SHELLEY. Oh uh

Honestly

I thought about getting back at my mom

**EMMA**. Whoa what really

SHELLEY. Yeah I mean at first

That's not why I went through with it obviously but yeah

When I was 15 I uh

I had to write an essay on a famous feminist

And my mom God rest her soul

she was a famous feminist herself

and a diehard atheist

(Ugh I can't get the crud off the bottom of this pot)

(SHELLEY scrubs vigorously.)

So I wrote my essay on a Catholic Feminist I thought that would really upset her Yet still fulfill the requirements of the course

EMMA. Your mom was famous?

**SHELLEY**. In certain circles

Academia

She wasn't like Gloria Steinem or anything

EMMA. Oh yeah

Who's Gloria Steinem again?

SHELLEY. Oh

Wow

Really

(Beat.)

She's a famous feminist.

EMMA. And she's a nun

SHELLEY. No, no she's not a

I did my report on Dorothy Day

**EMMA**. ...

SHELLEY. Dorothy Day devoted her life to the homeless?

Started the Catholic Worker

No offense but you were actually in college right

EMMA. Not that long

SHELLEY. Ok well I'm bringing books and

You're going to have to read them

EMMA. Why were you so pissed off at your mom

SHELLEY. Because she married my dad

Who was

Well let's just say wasn't the kindest

Isn't

the kindest man in the world

EMMA. He's still alive?

SHELLEY. Yes but he's very sick

EMMA. I'm sorry

(SHELLEY makes a non-committal noise. EMMA changes the subject.)

It's funny I always thought people became nuns

Because they had like I don't know

Visions

Or like God came to them in the night and was like

"Come with me"

SHELLEY. Oh that happened too

**EMMA**. Wait what

SHELLEY. Yeah I mean much later but

Ha

It's not that interesting

EMMA. Oh c'mon

What was it

What was it

SHELLEY. It was technically more of a dream than a vision

EMMA. Yeah but what was it.

SHELLEY. Uh

Well

I had this dream about this boy in my school ...Rob Kolker

#### EMMA. Oooooh

SHELLEY. Yeah it was not like that ok

He was a junior when I was a freshman

Everyone had a crush on him he wore a cowboy hat and later he ended up living on a sailboat

Anyway

In the dream I was wearing a dress

I was wearing the dress I wore to my high school prom and I used to have horrible eczema in high school Do you know what that is

EMMA. Yeah like scales

**SHELLEY**. Uh yeah

Sort of

So in the dream my eczema was out of control it manifested as these

huge weeping sores and I

I was awash in shame

I felt like an affront to humanity

Like how dare a go around offending the world with my...

# (SHELLEY gestures again to her whole self.)

And in my dream I was curled up in Rob Kolker's lap and he was looking down at me right at my arm

My scaly arm

and I felt a kind of stabbing shame

I wanted to die

I wanted to die

I knew that he must be looking at me with contempt or disgust or

I was waiting to be annihilated by his disgust but instead he said...

(Beat.)

**EMMA**. What did he say

SHELLEY. He said

...You are adorable

(Beat.)

And he was looking down at me with such gentleness

That I understood I was

Received

in my entirety

weeping sores and all

that my body was not an affront but a

I'm sorry I know this sounds dorky

but I don't have any other words

I understood that my body was holy

that I am holy

And when I woke up

I knew that it was possible to look at myself like this

and at others

with gentleness

with

(Beat.)

Adoration

(Pause.)

EMMA. Huh

SHELLEY. Yeah it's hard to

It loses something in the speaking

EMMA. But don't you ever want that with someone in real life

I know you have God

but sometimes don't you just want Rob Kolker?

(Beat.)

**SHELLEY.** Sure

(Making a joke:)

But you know I have a cat so

EMMA. Ohhhh

what's its name

**SHELLEY**. Pumpkin

EMMA. Orange?

**SHELLEY.** Yup my little niece named him

when she was four

Sophie I love her like crazy

EMMA. Yeah I get it

I have two nieces and

I love them both so much I could die

**SHELLEY**. Ha yes sometimes I feel like I love Sophie and Pumpkin so much I could die

(Awkard beat.)

Do you mind bringing in the rest of the dishes

**EMMA.** Sure

(EMMA starts to exit.)

SHELLEY. Emma

Why don't you do some research and

I'll ask Tasha if there are funds

We could put towards a job program

EMMA. Wait really

SHELLEY. Yeah why not

She'll probably say no but what the heck

(EMMA exits. SHELLEY looks after EMMA, and then to the microwave.)

Give her more time here to know you

To know herself

Touch gently this life that you have created

(She crosses herself.)

### Scene Ten

(The middle of the night.)

(EMMA and OSCAR stand facing each other in the darkness.)

EMMA. I think I'm sleepwalking

OSCAR. I am turning on the light ok

I'm turning on the light

(He turns on the light.)

EMMA. Boo!

(He reacts. She starts laughing.)

Remember that freaky face

Remember how scared you were by that / freaky face

**OSCAR**. I'm really sorry that you're sick

But I can't be talking to you right now

I have a girlfriend

Rosa

I'm in love with Rosa

and I'm going to ask her to be my wife

and we are going to live

Like this ok

(OSCAR makes FROG's church gesture with his hands.)

Holding one another up and so I can't fuck that up do you understand I cannot fuck that up

EMMA. Yeah I totally get it

OSCAR. Then what are you doing here

EMMA. I can't sleep

I can't sleep anymore and I'm hungry You got anything to eat

(Beat.)

#### OSCAR. Yeah

(He goes to the fridge.)

Rosa packed me a late night snack you can have it I'm not that hungry

Here you go

I'm going to go check the playground and you can go ahead and eat as much as you / want

EMMA. you're not going to catch my cancer

OSCAR. Please don't do this to me

EMMA. What you can't have a meal with me?

I can't sleep and I

I need some fucking

Human

Company

I'm very alone

I'm very alone

and also I'm dying

I'm dying so fuck you

you didn't run off when I was sucking your cock and now you can't have a simple human meal with me

Fuck you if you can't have a simple

human meal with me

(Beat.)

OSCAR. Hey look / I

EMMA. Fuck you

(He sighs. He starts laying out the food.)

OSCAR. C'mon Emma

I'm sorry

Let's eat together

C'mon

I'm a jerk

(She won't eat.)

Let's have a special human meal

(She won't look at him.)

Hey

You know what's delicious is

Clementines

(He starts peeling it.)

This Clementine

Mmmmmmm

I wouldn't want to miss out on this

This is sweet

and

delicious

(Beat.)

Here one slice c'mon

(She takes one. She puts in her mouth.)

EMMA. I've had better

OSCAR. Look I'm sorry I was a jerk...

EMMA. I am a little crazy Oscar

**OSCAR**. Yeah I know

EMMA. No I mean since I've been sick

Everything feels so out of my control

and I can't

I'm sort of following my impulses because

well why not

why not right

and I'm sorry I'm so sorry

I don't want to mess up your relationship with Rosa

but I think I'm going to

Because right now what I want

is more important than Rosa

and it's more important than you

And what I want

is for you to feed me another piece of this Clementine ok

OSCAR. Jesus you're a piece of work

EMMA. So are you

You are so beautiful Oscar you really are You're a piece of work

OSCAR. Oh c'mon stop it

I'm a man I'm not beautiful

(They are holding hands.)

I mean I'm

...guapo

(They are holding hands. EMMA begins to exert a small amount of pressure on OSCAR's hand until she has guided it to the Clementine. She wraps his fingers around it and guides it toward her mouth. He feeds her the Clementine.)

Oh man

#### Scene Eleven

(FROG is showered and a slightly nicer shirt. He holds a bouquet of daisies. OSCAR enters.)

**OSCAR**. Hey Hey Papi shampoo!

FROG. What the heck does that mean

OSCAR. Papi shampoo look at you!

You a ladies man today

"Papi Shampoo" that means like a playa

It means you wash your hair

for the ladies

FROG. Hey cut it out man

OSCAR. Why you look so nice Frog?

What you got flowers for you got a lady

FROG. Nah man

I've been staying somewhere

Emma she hooked me up with a shelter

over on Broadway

They've got a shower

OSCAR. Yeah but who are the flowers for

FROG. Who do you think dummy

Emma

Emma had her final chemo session today

So I brought her some flowers man

What'd you bring her

OSCAR. Oh

Uh

I can't encourage her you know that

I'm trying to make things work with Rosa

Emma set you up good huh?

FROG. Yes, actually she did

She made some calls on my behalf and now

Well

I've got a job interview

OSCAR. Wow man that's fantastic

FROG. Yeah let's not

Even keel my friend ok

It's just a reception job

I'd be a receptionist at a shelter for the Mentally Ill so that's confusing right

OSCAR. Nah Frog it's great

**FROG**. When I was a kid my bubby

she worked at a retirement home

taking care of old Jewish ladies

and I always thought it was a little strange

because she was an old Jewish lady herself

so who was taking care of her?

**OSCAR.** Well good luck man

FROG. Yeah I just gotta try to be consistent

that's going to be the issue

Consistency is not my strong suit

being on time that kind of thing

Plus I have to be on top of the medication

So we'll see

(Beat.)

OSCAR. Hey do you think

Do you think those flowers could be from me too

FROG. What no way my friend no way

Do you know what I had to do to get these flowers

OSCAR. C'mon please I don't want to look like an asshole

FROG. No way

(SHELLEY enters.)

**SHELLEY.** Hey are those for Emma

**OSCAR**. Yeah

**FROG**. They're from me

SHELLEY. We can have a little party I brought this cake

OSCAR. Oh man

I'll be right back

(OSCAR exits.)

SHELLEY. I brought candles too is that weird?

FROG. No way candles are beautiful let's do candles

(She takes the candles from the bag, hands some to **FROG**.)

(They start putting them on the cake.)

(As they're working:)

Hey Shelley

Ask me if I'm an Orange

SHELLEY. Are you an orange

FROG. No

SHELLEY. That's a good one

You look nice today, Frog.

FROG. Emma she set me up with these new duds and she got me a job interview

It's for next week next Wednesday at 2 p.m.

I don't know if you heard

SHELLEY. I did hear and I think it's wonderful

FROG. How come you never set me up, Shelley

SHELLEY. I don't know

...I'm sorry

**FROG.** You're smart right you're a really smart girl Why do you kowtow to authority sister

Why aren't you your own authority

The Catholic Church

C'mon

**SHELLEY.** Well you disagree with a lot of the choices made by this country right

Why do you stay in this country

FROG. Oh believe me

I've tried to make a go of it in other places

SHELLEY. Right but you came back here

FROG. Ok but I'm saying what's your deal Why are you helping out these losers Why do you care about these losers

SHELLEY. I'm helping you Frog you're not a loser

FROG. No way Emma helped me

You never helped me

**SHELLEY.** Well I have helped you Frog quite a few times you might not remember

FROG. Emma helped me

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. Ok you know what I don't want to argue this is Emma's / day and I

(EMMA enters. She looks wrecked.)

FROG. Hey! Here's our sunshine!

Look at her

You look great kid how do you feel

(FROG presents his flowers.)

These are for you

EMMA. Oh

Wow

Thanks

FROG. Shelley got you a cake too but we can wait on that

SHELLEY. I bet you're exhausted

(EMMA starts to cry.)

EMMA. No I'm fine I'm sorry

FROG. you need a joke you want a joke

SHELLEY. I bet you just need some sleep Why don't you go home and we'll celebrate another time

EMMA. I can't be around my mom right now

We got in this stupid fight because I borrowed some money

I took 10 bucks out of her purse so I could get something to eat on the way to chemo and she freaked out like I'm some kind of criminal

**SHELLEY.** Wait she didn't take you to the hospital Who took you to the / hospital?

EMMA. I go by myself

It's worse for me if she comes

FROG. Hey if your mom is abusive
you should stay with Shelley
I mean I'd let you stay at my place
but I don't think you qualify
But Shelley you live in an apartment right

SHELLEY. Uh yeah

Yes I do

Emma I'm happy to have you stay ...If that's what you need

FROG. Oh yeah party at Shelley's

**FROG.** On year party at shelley's

EMMA. No no I don't need a place to stay

FROG. Look if your mom's abusive you gotta tell us ok

EMMA. Please stop I'm fine it's fine

(OSCAR enters.)

OSCAR. Hey Emma

Congratulations

I got you this Bear

just a little Bear

I wanted to say congratulations so

it's a Jellycat bear

FROG. Oh yeah they sell those at the Rite Aid

(OSCAR glares at FROG.)

EMMA. Thanks Oscar

(She takes the Jellycat bear and cradles it.)

Oh my god I love it so much

SHELLEY. Why don't we light these candles

## **FROG**. I got it

(FROG lights the candles with a zippo from his pocket.)

Make a wish

(EMMA makes a wish. She blows out the candles, but only a few go out.)

#### EMMA. Oh no

SHELLEY. It's ok you'll still get your / wish

(Suddenly FROG lunges in and grabs all the remaining candles with his bare hand to put out the flame.)

(EMMA screams.)

SHELLEY. (calm) OSCAR

Frog Shit
Give me your hand Oh man

C'mon let's go to the sink What is wrong with you

man

FROG. What

What

(SHELLEY holds FROG's hand under the faucet.)

She got her wish

#### Scene Twelve

(SHELLEY on the phone, mid-conversation.)

**SHELLEY**. I apologize I'm not trying to interfere in a family situation

but please know that Emma is welcome to stay with me for as long as she –

Right

No that's not what I meant

I'm sorry

It's just that Emma has been a great help around here And we'd like to return the favor

We'd like to support your family during this difficult time –

What?

(Long beat.)

No I assumed you knew that she was working here otherwise I would never have... Uh huh

(Beat.)

No she doesn't know I'm calling ...you're her emergency contact

(Long beat.)

I think we should meet as soon as possible

(OSCAR enters and lingers by the counter.)

We're in the Bronx on the corner of 167<sup>th</sup> and Yes I can come to you Let me get a pen

(OSCAR takes a sandwich out of the fridge.)

(He's conspicuously distracted.)

Go ahead

(SHELLEY writes.)

Uh huh

I'll see you there

(She hangs up.)

Have you seen Emma

(Beat.)

OSCAR. What

No

No

**SHELLEY.** Ok well I have to go out / for a while

OSCAR. Rosa and I just broke up

**SHELLEY.** Oh no I'm so sorry

**OSCAR**. Yeah she uh

Do you have an iPhone 4?

SHELLEY. Yeah I think so or no it's a 4S

OSCAR. Yeah but you know what a pass code is right

SHELLEY. Uh

OSCAR. It protects your phone

So nobody can read your texts or emails

Here I'll show you

(He takes out his phone and starts showing her:)

See my phone is locked right now so you can't read my private things and then I put in my code and there I can see everything

**SHELLEY**. Uh huh

**OSCAR.** But the iPhone 4 has a little uh

The thing about these dudes in California

I think a lot of them don't have girlfriends.

They're computer guys so they don't have girlfriends and so they didn't test this pass code feature carefully you know what I'm saying?

Watch this:

See this is my camera ok you see that

SHELLEY. Yup.

OSCAR. And even though the phone is locked

The camera icon still appears for some reason and when I press the icon it opens right up to my camera

and then Shelley look at this!

I am in the phone

I am in the phone

pass code does not protect me

SHELLEY. I'm not sure I

OSCAR. You know how I figured out this little problem?

I didn't

Rosa figured it out

Rosa figured it out

She figured it out and she read all my texts and now I'm dead I'm a dead man!

(OSCAR is overcome by his shitty situation.)

**SHELLEY.** Are you saying that Rosa read something you didn't want her to read?

OSCAR. (not looking up) Yeah that crazy girl she texted me (Beat.)

**SHELLEY**. Emma?

OSCAR. Yeah I don't know why but she texted me some wild shit

and Rosa I think she misunderstood

because this stuff she texted was out of / control

**SHELLEY.** You know what I need to go and this none of my business

OSCAR. Wait are you pissed are you pissed at me?

**SHELLEY**. I have to go meet someone

So I'd rather not be talking to you about this right now

OSCAR. you're pissed you look pissed

SHELLEY. Yeah well maybe I am a little

But not at you

I'm just going through some things too

Oscar

OSCAR. Oh man Shelly I'm sorry what is it

SHELLEY. Never mind

OSCAR. Come on we're friends right you can / tell me

SHELLEY. I'll see you tomorrow.

OSCAR. Please don't stay mad at me

SHELLEY. I'm not mad at you I just told you that

OSCAR. Yeah but are you disappointed in me

(Beat.)

SHELLEY. Yes actually

I am a little disappointed in you

(Long beat.)

But I'll get over it

#### Scene Thirteen

(SHELLEY and EMMA sitting in the kitchen. EMMA's head is uncovered. She wears her hair like she did in the first scene.)

(Long Silence.)

EMMA. It just came out of my mouth

and then once I said it

I couldn't take it back

and the more I kept pretending

the more it started to feel true to me

It was kind of a relief

like thank God now I can stop pretending that I'm ok all the time

It's like the outside finally

made sense with the inside

I'm sorry it sounds so stupid to say it out loud

but I feel like I have cancer

SHELLEY. Right but you don't

EMMA. I mean on the inside

SHELLEY. Real cancer happens on the inside

EMMA. Right but I'm saying it felt true / to me

SHELLEY. No I'm sorry that's not acceptable

EMMA. So what you think I'm what evil?

SHELLEY. What

No

No I don't think you're evil

I think that you lied

You lied about something very big

EMMA. But you're a nun aren't you / supposed to

SHELLEY. You told me your mother abused you

EMMA. I never said that

Frog said it

SHELLEY. Did your mother abuse you

EMMA. No not physically / but

**SHELLEY.** What emotionally psychologically welcome to the club.

EMMA. I don't know I can't explain it

SHELLEY. Did your mother abuse you?

**EMMA**. No, no not exactly it's just that / I

SHELLEY. You just feel like she did

EMMA. No that's not what I / said

**SHELLEY**. Because from what I can tell your mother loves you like crazy

Working two jobs to put you through college

EMMA. I know that!

**SHELLEY.** And this isn't the first time right

This is a pattern your mother told me this / is a

EMMA. Yes /

Yes

SHELLEY. You never went to college She paid for your whole first semester and you never even went to / class

**EMMA.** I was depressed I couldn't get out of bed! There's something wrong with me

and no one can even see it

I'm in all this pain

and no one can even see it

It's like I've been through a fucking war or something

**SHELLEY**. Please stop it's offensive comparing your / pain to

EMMA. I'm sorry I'm not comparing

I thought you were supposed to be compassionate

(The bell rings four times.)

SHELLEY. Emma I need to start dinner
I appreciate you coming up here
to talk to me in person that was brave
But I don't think it's right

for you to continue working here

EMMA. What

SHELLEY. You need to take some time to figure this out with your family with the people who love you Your mom and I talked she's going to find someone for you a psychologist or / a

#### EMMA. HELP ME

(Beat.)

I'm sorry I'm sorry I yelled

SHELLEY. I have to do the responsible thing Emma
There are a lot of people who depend on me
to get them through the day
You have a family who loves you
who is ready to get you the help that you need
EMMA. Please forgive me

(Beat. SHELLEY looks down at the floor.)

You can't even look at me You can forgive everyone in this whole stupid world except me

SHELLEY. I'm not qualified to help you Emma

EMMA. You're a nun

I mean if a nun isn't qualified to

Love

To forgive

Then what the fuck am I supposed to do

HELP ME

HELP ME

HELP / ME

(OSCAR comes running in.)

**OSCAR.** What the heck What happened

Are you ladies all right?

(EMMA runs into his arms.)

Hey whoa

whoa

You're all right

SHELLEY. I'm calling your mom Emma.

OSCAR. What's going on

SHELLEY. She doesn't have cancer

OSCAR. ...You're clean?

EMMA. Well yeah but

(OSCAR shouts in joy.)

**OSCAR**. That's fantastic

(He picks EMMA up off of the ground.)

Thank you/ God

EMMA. No no no no Oscar stop put me / down it's

OSCAR. Yeah it's too much I understand it's a lot of emotion

SHELLEY. No no it's not it's not a lot of emotion!

Emma tell him

you should tell him yourself

(Long beat. EMMA is too ashamed to say it.)

...She lied.

OSCAR. What

SHELLEY. She never had cancer she lied

OSCAR. Oh

(Beat.)

That's weird

EMMA. Yeah

Yes

I don't know why I

It was my first day and

I felt like Shelley was judging me

SHELLEY. Wait what are you blaming me now?

EMMA. No no I'm not saying it's your fault

I take responsibility I do I can't handle the thought that someone might be mad at me or might not like me

**OSCAR**. But you were

You had like the thing on your chest for the chemo

EMMA. I did that myself I got some gauze and I'm sorry oh my god I'm / so sorry

OSCAR. You brought pictures

EMMA. Those were real!

He was my doctor when I was fifteen and I had my appendix out and everybody sent me flowers

(Beat.)

He really was my doctor

(Pause.)

OSCAR. Ok

Uh

I don't understand what's going on but you definitely don't have cancer right?

EMMA. I don't have cancer.

(Beat.)

OSCAR. So that's something to be thankful for
I'm happy for you
because no one deserves cancer
My mom went through it and it was terrible
so I'm going to knock on some wood for you

(He walks over to the counter. He knocks on wood. He exits.)

**SHELLEY.** You should go Emma I need to / start the **EMMA.** What if I start seeing a psychologist Could I keep working here if I see a psychologist

like you said

(Beat.)

Please I respect whatever decision you make but working here is the only good I have done in my life I've done good here you know that I've done good

**SHELLEY**. ... Yes you have.

EMMA. Maybe you could let me stay for a trial period I'll do extra work around here whatever you want Please look at me with gentleness

SHELLEY. ... What

**EMMA**. Please look at me with whatever you said With adoration

(Long beat.)

**SHELLEY**. If you want to stay for the afternoon I could use the help

and I think you should tell the guys yourself

**EMMA**. Yes absolutely

SHELLEY. ... Why don't you go out and wipe down the tables

EMMA. Thank you

SHELLEY. You're welcome.

(EMMA goes to the closet and gets spray and rag. She exits. SHELLEY keeps prepping for a few moments, then walks over to the microwave.)

I know that I may not be looking at this situation with much clarity

I've been lied to so many times in my life that I'm having a hard time trusting myself here

(Long pause.)

She's one of the poor right? That's why she's here

(The microwave keeps running. **SHELLEY** just stands there for a few moments.)

(FROG enters.)

FROG. Hey Shelley

(SHELLEY shuts off the microwave.)

**SHELLEY.** Oh hey / Frog

**FROG.** Emma told me she told me and I just want to say what a stupid asshole that girl is

SHELLEY. Ha

Well

Yes

FROG. But you should let her stay

**SHELLEY**. Frog this is none of your / business

FROG. People are fucked up Shelley

Angels and assholes

Me for example I'm an asshole but I've got a good heart

And she's done so much around here

Shelley

Shelley

I'm going on two more job interviews next week

Emma did that

SHELLEY. I know she did

FROG. This fucked up thing she did is mysterious

but she's a 19-year old girl

and that's a mysterious type of person

And she didn't hurt anyone not really

I mean if she was your kid you'd have to forgive her right?

and isn't she your kid Shelley

Look at your Vocation

I would say that she's your kid

SHELLEY. I don't know if that's how I interpret

my vocation

Frog

But I hear you

I have a lot of work to do in here

FROG. Oh yeah I know
I just wanted to advocate

Just know she has an advocate

SHELLEY. I hear you

(FROG exits. SHELLEY dumps out a huge bag of potatoes. She starts chopping. After a bit, EMMA enters and returns her cleaning supplies to the closet. She stands looking at SHELLEY.)

(After a bit:)

OFPROTESSIONAL

Do you mind helping me with these potatoes

(EMMA nods, overwhelmed with relief.)

#### Scene Fourteen

(Several months later.)

(FROG in the kitchen. He wears a spiffy shirt and a clip-on tie, and a winter hat. He looks cleaned up and better than we've seen him yet. He is holding a potato to his ear like it's a phone.)

FROG. Good morning Bronx Community Residence and Mental Health Facility Good morning Bronx Community Residence and Mental Health Facility Uh

(He can't remember what to say next.

Good Morning Good Morning

> (EMMA enters carrying several bags of bread, and other supplies. She wears a thick winter jacket over more grown up clothes. Her hair is up. She looks more mature, professional.)

> (She starts putting things away as if she owns this kitchen.)

Good morning Bronx Community Residence and Mental Health Facility

Uh

Uh

EMMA. How may I help you

FROG. How may I help you

EMMA. I don't know because I'm totally crazy

FROG. Well ok then

You know what you should do if you're totally crazy You should come and meet with one of our trained social workers.

**EMMA**. Keep going

**FROG**. We provide

Transitional services for those

Transitioning

Transitional services for those Transitioning

That can't be right it's redundant

EMMA. It sounds fine they get the picture

(SHELLEY comes in from the cafeteria with an arm full of dishes and sets them down.)

**SHELLEY.** I think this is the last of it Sheesh

(SHELLEY starts gathering cleaning supplies.)

FROG. Bunch of pigs

**SHELLEY**. Actually everyone's been very polite today You look handsome Frog

FROG. Yeah I know

Today's my first day I start at five can't mess it up It took me a million interviews to get this job I gotta show up with the goods

**SHELLEY**. I know you've got the goods Emma how are we looking for dinner

EMMA. We're ok for tonight but we should double the bread order next week
We've been getting a lot of families
Little kids it's depressing

SHELLEY. I'll check the budget but I can't make any promises

EMMA. I think Reya will give us a deal

**SHELLEY.** Great bring me back a quote Also can you be in charge of tomorrow's list

**EMMA**. Absolutely

Can I experiment?

(SHELLEY's phone rings. She checks the number.)

SHELLEY. Sure but no cilantro it weirds me out

(SHELLEY answers her phone as she walks back out to the dining room.)

Hey Sophie how's Grandpa

Hey honey it's ok

I'm here I'm right here what's going on

(She exits. FROG goes right back to practicing.)

FROG. Hi thanks for holding

We're located at

We're located at

Jesus my mind

my mind is totally shot

Sometime around 1974 the atomic bomb

went off in there and now it's a radiated field

How the hell can I do this when I've got no memory

EMMA. It's 5670 Riverdale

FROG. 5670 Riverdale

EMMA. Try it again.

**FROG**. 5, 6

oh god

EMMA. It's easy Frog;

5, 6, 7 that's all in a row and then you go back to zero Plus you've got a memory if you can remember 1974

FROG. Yeah but that's the last year I remember

Or maybe I'm just hungry

EMMA. You want a sandwich?

FROG. Nah I got stop for a while

This is too heady for me I'd rather clean tables

EMMA. Go for it

(FROG goes to the closet and grabs some cleaner and a rag. He exits. EMMA continues cleaning. Contentedly.)

(After a few moments, **SHELLEY** re-enters. She looks a little disoriented, maybe like she's been crying.

She stands still for a moment, as if she's not sure what to do with herself.)

Everything ok out there

SHELLEY. Uh yes

Fine

How's Frog doing?

EMMA. He says he has memory problems

But I think he's just scared

SHELLEY. You've done a great job with him

With everything

In fact your work here since

(Beat.)

Your work over the past few months has been terrific you've made changes I didn't think were possible and Tasha and I agreed that if you're interested we'd like to put you on salary

(Pause.)

Are you ok

EMMA. Yes oh my god thank you yes

SHELLEY. Oh good

Ha

I was worried you were going to say no

I'm so relieved

Tasha will deal with all the paperwork

she'll have to train you too sorry

I have to fly out to California for a week or so

EMMA. Oh

Wow

SHELLEY. Yeah my dad uh

he's been moved home he's ready to go Finally

EMMA. I'm so sorry

SHELLEY. Thank you

I'm hoping he and I can Well I'm not sure what I'm hoping

(Beat. EMMA's not sure what to say.)

**EMMA**. Can I do anything

SHELLEY. You know what yes I was going to ask – would you be willing to take care of my place while I'm gone look after Pumpkin, water my plants If it's not too much trouble

EMMA. Of course not whatever you need

SHELLEY. That's wonderful thank you
You're welcome to stay there too
Pumpkin would love the company
If you don't mind playing with him
and petting him a lot
He's a very spoiled cat
why don't you stop by when we're done here
and I can show you how he likes things

емма. На

Sure

SHELLEY. Oh and in terms of this place
Tasha will be in charge of the kitchen
while I'm gone so

EMMA. Oh I thought you might put me in charge SHELLEY. I think it's a little soon for that EMMA. I know I'm sorry I'll just miss you.

(OSCAR enters.)

Hey Oscar

**OSCAR**. Hey

Just here to get my leftovers

(He opens the refrigerator, grabs his leftovers and leaves.)

EMMA. Do you think he'll ever talk to me again?

#### SHELLEY. Give him time

(Beat.)

Hey

Look at this

(SHELLEY pulls a nun's habit out of a huge plastic bag.)

**EMMA**. What is that

Is that a nun dress?

**SHELLEY.** Well yes but more importantly it's a basketball dress

**EMMA**. Whoa no way

SHELLEY. Oh yeah

I don't know if you know this about me

But I was the leading point guard in Northern California

Triple A ball

and when I come back from this trip

I am heading across the street

And I am going to dominate those girls

(EMMA starts laughing.)

ЕММА. На

Yes I will be there

SHELLEY. I am going to ruin those girls.

#### Scene Fifteen

(EMMA is alone in the kitchen, blasting music.)

(She chops vegetables and throws them violently into the soup.)

(She pulls some spices down from above the stove and starts adding them to the pot.)

(OSCAR enters.)

OSCAR. HEY

EMMA. OH HEY YOU'RE TALKING TO ME NOW

OSCAR. OH C'MON DON'T BE LIKE THAT HOW'S IT GOING HERE WITH TASHA

EMMA. I FUCKING HATE TASHA BUT SHE'S GONE TODAY

(She turns down the music.)

It's all fine

Tasha's fine.

**OSCAR.** No she's not she's scary I'm sorry you have to deal with that

EMMA. Me too it's like penal servitude here now whatever I can take it

OSCAR. We need Shelley man

EMMA. Yeah no shit

She's gotta stay longer

I don't know what's going on

But her family sounds crazy

OSCAR. Oh man poor Shelley

EMMA. Yeah and poor me

I'm going insane here without her

OSCAR. Yeah

Yeah

(Beat.)

Soup smells good

**EMMA**. I'm trying out some new stuff Fennel

OSCAR. Cool

(Beat.)

Listen

I want to tell you

Uh

I mean I know I don't need to tell you this but I want everything to be out in the open So I want to tell you that I asked Rosa to marry me

(Beat.)

EMMA. Good for you

**OSCAR**. Yeah

Yeah

And she said yes

EMMA. That's fantastic.

OSCAR. Yeah it is right?

And listen to be clear

I didn't tell her everything about us but I did have to tell her some things you know because of the texts which I realize you had every right to send

I realize that I was equally responsible

for what happened

and you had a right to send those texts and I'm sorry that Rosa saw them

but that is not your fault

(Beat.)

Are you ok

EMMA. Yeah

I hope you'll be super happy

OSCAR. Thank you

(Pause.)

So to be clear

I'm not

except for telling you this

I'm not supposed to talk to you

(Beat.)

EMMA. ...Ok

**OSCAR**. Yeah

So

EMMA. So see ya

(Pause. EMMA is doing her best not to break down.)

OSCAR. Oh c'mon Emma

You knew I had a girlfriend when / you

EMMA. Please stop talking to me

You're not supposed to talk to me

I'm a piece of shit and you're not supposed to / talk to me

**OSCAR.** Stop it you're an amazing girl and I have real admiration

for how you turned your life around and I'm just trying to do the same

I'm trying to make a life / with Rosa

EMMA. Jesus I get it just leave me alone

OSCAR. I'm sorry I'm just trying to say

that you're a beautiful girl

or you know woman

human being and I / really wish

EMMA. Oh my god can you please

Can you please just

GET THE FUCK OUT OF HERE

(She turns the music back up.)

(She goes back to chopping.)

(OSCAR stands there for a moment watching her.)

```
(He exits.)

(EMMA chops.)

(She cuts her finger.)

Shit

Shit

(She runs to the faucet and puts it under water.)

(She stands there and silently counts to 20.)

(She takes off her apron, goes to the soup, turns it down to a simmer and walks out the door.)
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#### Scene Sixteen

(SHELLEY alone in the kitchen sobbing.)

(She tries to recover when OSCAR enters.)

OSCAR. Shelley girl are you ok

Hey c'mon Shelley

(She starts crying again.)

(OSCAR grabs her some paper towels and hands them to her.)

(He pours her a glass of water.)

Here

Here

Drink this

C'mon Shelley

Drink this.

(She drinks.)

Man you were thirsty

You ok

Shelley you ok

(SHELLEY nods.)

SHELLEY. Has Emma been in yet

**OSCAR**. What no

She ditched us while you were out of town

Tasha's been working by herself for a couple of weeks

We haven't heard from Emma

**SHELLEY**. She uh

She didn't feed my cat

(Beat.)

OSCAR. She didn't feed your

(SHELLEY starts to cry again.)

Oh shit

## SHELLEY. He must have thought

He thought I abandoned him

The whole apartment was

He had torn up the whole apartment

looking for food

and water

He shit all over the place he just died there

desperate

Thinking I'd abandoned him

Why didn't you

Why didn't you

Why the fuck didn't anyone call me?

### **OSCAR**. Shelley

#### SHELLEY. You or

Tasha why didn't you why didn't you call me

If Emma didn't come to work for 2 weeks

Why didn't you call me

I was

I had a lot to deal with

I didn't check in because

I had a lot to

My dad was dying

Oh my god

He didn't have any water

He didn't have any / water

## (FROG enters.)

# FROG. Hey you guys

Hey Shelley

Shelly

What's going on

Are you ok Shelley

You need a joke

You wanna hear a joke

OSCAR. Hey man c'mon give her some space

FROG. Hey Shelley two penguins are sitting in a bathtub

OSCAR. C'mon man leave her alone

She's having a hard day

FROG. (fairly calm at first) Oh yeah I know me too

you know why?

There's fucking a government guy following me

oh yeah

oh yeah

He's about 5'9"

very nondescript

that's the kind of guy the CIA sends

the kind of guy that blends right in

think I won't notice

fuck you motherfuckers

OSCAR. Frog man what's going on

Why aren't you at work

**FROG**. Because they know where I work now Oscar

They've got their people disguised in the waiting room

OSCAR. Hey did you forget your medication

Did you take your medication today

FROG. Can you look outside and see if he's there

He's wearing a tie

He's wearing a tie just like this one

because you know what they do

They mock you

They mock you

Throw it back in your face

Look at you sucker working a fucking desk job

Look at what the fuck you are

A nothing

A nothing

OSCAR. Hey calm down ok

Can you hand me your bag

I'm gonna find you some / medication

(OSCAR grabs for FROG's bag and FROG suddenly turns on him and starts flailing, trying to wrestle the bag out of OSCAR's hands.)

FROG. DON'T TOUCH MY SHIT
DON'T TOUCH MY SHIT ASSHOLE

SHELLEY. FROG

CALM DOWN.

(Beat.)

FROG. ...Ok

**SHELLEY.** Listen to me Frog

I'm gonna go check

and see if that CIA dude is still out there

and if he's out there

I'm going to deal with him

(Beat.)

FROG. Thanks

Shelley.

(She gets up and walks out the back door and shuts it.)

(FROG watches after her anxiously.)

OSCAR. Hey man

I didn't mean to scare you

(SHELLEY walks back in.)

FROG. Was he out there

SHELLEY, Yeah

He was out there

FROG. (to OSCAR) I told you!

SHELLEY. I said he needed to leave you alone

I told him if the CIA didn't back off

We were gonna sue their asses

and take them for everything they've got

and he got scared

and he agreed to leave

FROG. He did

SHELLEY. Yes he did

So you're safe Frog

you're safe

and I want you to drink some water ok

Oscar can you get him a cup

**OSCAR**. Sure

SHELLEY. (as she digs through FROG's bag) We've taken care

of the CIA guy

and now we're gonna get you back to your house Ok We're gonna get you back to your living situation

(Beat.)

FROG. Yeah

Ok

Thanks Shelley

SHELLEY. And can I look through your bag Frog?

Can I see if you have some medication

that might help you sleep?

Because I think after all they've put you through you deserve to rest

(FROG nods.)

FROG. Yeah

Yeah

I do deserve to rest

Oh man

It's so hot in here

**SHELLEY**. Hey Oscar

Can you bring me a cold washcloth

OSCAR. Sure

SHELLEY. (pulling a pill container out of FROG's bag) Ok I

found these Frog

This is your Olanzapine

It's gonna help you deal with the stress

caused by these motherfuckers ok

FROG. Yeah

Yeah

You're sure they're not tampered with

**SHELLEY**. Nope this is a clean supply

I've checked them

It's a clean supply

(FROG takes the pill and puts it in his mouth.)

(He takes a drink of the water.)

(OSCAR hands SHELLEY the cloth.)

There you go you got it And lets cool you off ok Will you let me touch your face.

FROG. ...Yeah

(FROG lets SHELLEY wash his face.)

(He relaxes.)

SHELLEY. There you go

FROG. Shit they're evil you know

SHELLEY. I know

They are evil and I'm so sorry I'm so sorry you have to deal with this You don't deserve any of this

#### Scene Seventeen

(EMMA is waiting alone in the kitchen for SHELLEY.)

(After a bit, **SHELLEY** enters with an armful of dirty dishes. She is dressed in a contemporary nun's habit. A skirt and jacket. A modest headpiece.)

(She stops and looks at EMMA. Her face and stance are open, generous, kind.)

## EMMA. Thank you for seeing me

(SHELLEY nods.)

Luh

I'm going back to school upstate and I didn't want to leave without apologizing in person

SHELLEY. All right

(Beat.)

EMMA. Oscar said

He said you were leaving the church but you're dressed like / a

SHELLEY. I am leaving

this

Costume

was a last ditch effort to make it work I'm formally leaving tomorrow but until then

(Beat.)

I'm still giving it my all

**EMMA**. What will you do

 $(Beat. \ \textbf{SHELLEY} \ smiles.)$ 

SHELLEY. I have no idea

(EMMA looks down, sick with remorse.)

EMMA. I'm sorry I am so / sorry

SHELLEY. Emma I know that what you did

wasn't actively malicious

I know that you didn't deliberately

torture

another living creature

who was depending on you for survival

EMMA. Did you

My letter did you get / my

SHELLEY. I read it yes thank you

I've been reading it for the past month

I've read it maybe a hundred times

looking for some kind of...

(Beat.)

And thing is

I empathize with you Emma

with your

Depression - you said you ran away because you were

very

Depressed

and I understand that I do

I realize this might come as a surprise to you

but I have also experienced

quite a lot of depression

in my life

(Long beat. She looks at EMMA with genuine kindness.)

But even though I know that you were in pain

and that what you did was thoughtless

and not

actively malicious

I still believe with all my heart that it was evil

(Beat.)

EMMA. What

**SHELLEY**. It was evil and I'm relieved that tomorrow I will finally be rid of

(She gestures vaguely to her habit.)

Whatever obligation this gives me to forgive you

(The church bell rings three times.)

I need to finish cleaning up.

EMMA. Shelley

I promise you that

one day

I will be a different kind of person

a better kind of person

and even though I know this is something

I can never make right

I hope that one day

you'll be able to forgive me

SHELLEY. Emma I believe you

I believe that one day you will be

A different kind of person

A better kind of person

and I even believe that one day

I might be able to forgive you

But the thing is

(Long beat as **SHELLEY** searches her heart.)

I don't want to

(She is filled with a dawning sense of wonder:)

...I feel lighter

and freer

and strangely

...happy?

standing here right now knowing that

I don't ever have to forgive you

Ever

Ever

Ever

Ever

Ever

I don't wish you any harm Emma

but if I never forgive you that will be fine with me

I can live with that

(SHELLEY looks at EMMA with great gentleness.)

(After a bit:)

EMMA. Shelley I...

(Beat.)

I should go

(A kind of benediction:)

SHELLEY. Yes

(SHELLEY lets EMMA go.)

(SHELLEY watches EMMA disappear, and then finally allows herself to relax. She takes a deep breath. And another. She is filled with a growing elation, and eventually something resembling joy.)
